If more than two umpires are available, one shall be designated Umpire-in-Chief and the other umpires shall be field umpires [Rule 9.03(b)]. It is highly recommended that each team have their coaching staff District Certified in cases where umpires may be unavailable.
- 3. Prior to the start of the game, the home team shall provide two (2) new balls to the home plate umpire. This division uses yellow softballs of 11" in circumference (as defined in the current Little League Softball Official Regulations and Playing rules). No marking aside from factory lettering is allowed on the balls. The plate umpire may require additional balls during the game and select the best used balls for the teams.
- 4. The Host team is responsible for preparing and setting up the field, to include chalking forty-five minutes prior to game time. Player safety is essential and therefore it is mandatory that field prep include loosening then smoothing the dirt around 2nd and 3nd base and home plate (if on dirt field).
- 5. Weekday games will begin promptly at 6:15pm.
- 6. As a courtesy, during times of severe inclement weather it is requested that playing conditions be reviewed and games cancelled by 4pm, or two hours prior on non-weekday games, to save teams from traveling to a site that is unplayable.
- 7. The entire District will comprise the Inter-League.
- 8. Each manager will be provided with a list of managers' names, phone numbers and e-mail addresses.
- 9. PITCHING: This league is coach/machine pitch only and, because this is an instructional league, the adult may verbally coach from the eight-foot circle. The coach must pitch within the eight-foot circle. Each batter may have a maximum of eight (8) pitches. If the batter does not hit the ball by the eighth (8th) pitch, batter is out. The batter is out after three (3) strikes or when the maximum of eight (8) pitches have been delivered, whichever occurs first. No walks allowed. The batter will either hit the ball or strike out.
- 10. Continuous batting order is required at this level [Rule 4.04]. Each inning will end after three outs, five runs or one time through the batting order.
- 11. Time Limit: No inning will begin after ninety minutes from scheduled start time. A five (5) run limit is in effect per half inning for the minor league divisions per the definition of an inning in the rulebook [Rule 2.00]. Following the completion of the play in which the fifth (5th) run is scored in the half inning, the half inning will end. No more than five (5) runs will be recorded per half inning, no exceptions. This division will NOT adopt the option provided in Rule 5.07 to suspend the five (5) run limit.
- 12. No stealing. Failure to catch a called or swung strike or a wild pitch results in a dead ball. Runners may only advance on a hit or other play where they are required to advance (e.g., hit by pitch if a runner is already occupying first base.)

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- 13. No more than six defensive players are allowed on the infield. No limit on outfield players.
- 14. This division will adopt the reduced minimum play rule for rosters of 15 or more players. [Reg IV(i)]
- 15. When a team has only eight players in the game this division will not assess an out when the missing ninth batter position comes up to bat. [Rule 4.04]
- 16. This division will adopt the courtesy runner for pitcher/catcher with two outs. The courtesy runner must be the last previous out. [Rule 7.14(b)]

If only one umpire shows up a manager, coach or parent (if District Certified) may umpire in the field. At this time if the complete affidavit is not presented the game will be suspended and rescheduled for a later date. The game shall resume from the point that it was stopped. Remember, the number of innings pitched will count towards this game and week's total. The ADA and the league president of the league in violation will be notified at once. The penalties for failure to comply with this said rule are as follows:
 - a. 1st offense: 1 game suspension for the manager
 - b. 2nd offense: 3 game suspension for the manager
 - c. 3rd offense: Manager shall be removed from the team and will be ineligible for any all-star or tournament participation.

All pitching records shall be kept in ink. The penalties for failing to keep the affidavits in ink are the same as above.

11. PITCHING: There will only be two (2) walks per each half inning. Per half inning, the pitcher will continue to pitch until they have walked two batters. For purposes of this rule, batter being hit by pitch will count towards the two walks. After that time any batter who has acquired 4 balls will then be pitched to by their manager or coach, until that batter either hits or strikes out. The coach must pitch within the eight foot circle. The player pitcher will resume pitching with the next batter. A hit by pitch will always be awarded first

base. When the adult is on the field they must remain in the eight-foot circle at all times and move only after the play has stopped or if in danger of being hurt. If batter is hit by a pitch from an adult pitcher it will be considered a ball. If the adult interferes with any play the runners may not advance more than one base. THE ADULT PITCHER WILL NOT COACH FROM THE RUBBER OR DURING THE PITCH (Encouragement is allowed). If the adult pitcher does coach as a pitcher, it is interference and will be handled according to the rulebook. This rule does not allow for extra adults to come on to the field, no more than four (4) adults are allowed on the field per team and one (1) adult must remain in the dugout at all times. Although stealing bases is permitted at this level, a runner may not steal any base when there is an adult on the rubber.

- 15. When a team has only eight players in the game this division will not access an out when the missing ninth batter position comes up to bat. [Rule 4.04]
- 16. This division will adopt the courtesy runner for pitcher/catcher with two outs. The courtesy runner must be the last previous out. [Rule 7.14(b)]
- 17. Continuous batting order is required at this level [Rule 4.04]. Each inning will end after three outs, five runs or one time through the batting order.
- 18. A five (5) run limit is in effect per half inning for the minor league divisions per the definition of an inning in the rulebook [Rule 2.00]. Following the completion of the play in which the fifth (5th) run is scored in the half inning, the half inning will end. No more than five (5) runs will be recorded per half inning, no exceptions. This division WILL adopt the option provided in Rule 5.07 to suspend the five (5) run limit. It is strongly encouraged that the umpire invokes the 5.07 rule at the top of the inning.
- 19. A Runner at 3rd may not advance to home on any unhit pitch or throw back to the pitcher unless forced by base-on balls or hit batter. Stealing of home is allowed if a play is being made on any runner.
- 20. No on deck circle is allowed.
- 21. After a base-on balls the batter/runner may advance to first base only.

- 1. Weekday games will start at 6:15 p.m. and shall end at 8:15 p.m.
- 2. No new inning will start after 8:00 p.m.
- 3. Weekday games that start late will still be completed at 8:15 p.m.
- 4. Weekend games will have a time limit of 2 hours.
- 5. The home team takes infield for 10 minutes, 25 minutes before game time. The visiting team will take infield for 10 minutes, 15 minutes before game time.
- 6. Manager may play no more than ten (10) players defensively. i.e. Rover position 4th outfielder
 - a. Only (6) infielders on the dirt, including pitcher and catcher, are allowed.
- 7. No defensive manger or coach is allowed to be outside of the dugout during game play.
 - a. Defensive managers or coaches can backup catcher and field passed balls. (need waiver)
 - b. Offensive managers and coaches are not allowed to be in fair territory during game play.
- 8. Only five (5) runs may score per half inning.
- 9. Batting:
 - a. Continuous batting. All players in attendance for the game will bat.
 - b. Three (3) outs (made from regular baseball outs), scoring five (5) runs or one time through the batting order will retire the half inning.
 - i. Strike out count toward the three (3) outs per half inning.
 - ii. The on deck batter will bat first in the next inning.
 - iii. Dropped third strike considered an out; batter may not make an attempt to advance to first base.

10. Pitching:

- a. Once a pitcher has walked two (2) batters no more walks will be allowed by that pitcher. The coach will pitch to future batters if the same pitcher throws four (4) balls to subsequent batters. If a pitcher substitution occurs the coach will not pitch until the new pitcher has walked (2) batters.
 - i. Hit by Pitch will count towards the two walk limit. Hit by Pitch will always be awarded first base.
 - ii. Only an overhand pitching motion will be used by the coach.
 - iii. Batter will inherit the strikes from the youth pitcher
 - iv. Batter will either strike out or hit a pitched ball and cannot walk from a coach pitching.
 - v. Called strike counts toward count.
 - vi. Player that was pitching may continue to pitch to the next batter or can be removed at the manger's discretion.
- 11. Stealing is not allowed (including on passed balls).
- 12. Substitutes:
 - a. No player shall sit out for more than one (1) consecutive defensive inning.
 - b. No player may sit more than once a game subject to team size.

13. When a team has only eight players in the game this division will not assess an out when the missing ninth batter position comes up to bat. [Rule 4.04]

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Idaho District 2 Inter-league Rules Baseball Major/Minor Divisions 2021 Spring Season THESE RULES APPLY TO ALL INTER LEAGUE GAMES

1. There will be a joint Board of Directors that will govern the program. It will consist of the President of the league or the Vice-President/Director of the division involved or the Player-Agent for the same division. The District Administrator for the respective division will chair the board.

DISTRICT INTERLEAGUE PROTEST FORMAT: The protest committee will consist of the District Administrator (who is acting in the position of the League President during interleague play) or designated representative, District UIC or designated representative, and one board member from each league involved. Written statements will be accepted by the District Administrator, within 48 hours of the said game, by all involved parties. The committee will review the written statements submitted by the protesting team and the game UIC, as well as interview all parties involved at different time intervals (e.g. both team managers and the game UIC). Only those who are called for an interview will be allowed to attend. This process will take no longer than one week from the time the game was played. Once a ruling has been made, all parties will be notified in writing of the ruling.

- 2. All playing rules will be **STRICTLY** by the Little League Rule Book and Inter-league rules.
- 3. If after three (3) innings, one team has at least a lead of 15 runs or more, or if after four (4) innings, one team has at least a lead of 10 runs or more, the manager of the team with the least runs must concede. (Rule 4.10(e))
- 4. Each team will furnish a minimum of one certified umpire for all inter-league games. A manager or coach may umpire in the field if only one umpire shows up. If more than 2 umpires are present, they shall be allowed to umpire (see rule 9.03b). The home team shall provide the plate umpire. In the absence of 2 certified umpires, and the inability or unwillingness of a manager or coach to umpire, the game will be suspended and possibly re-scheduled.
- 5. Rescheduling of interleague games will be at the discretion of the individual leagues involved. Interleague games not played as scheduled are strongly encouraged to be rescheduled.
 - As a courtesy, during times of severe inclement weather it is requested that playing conditions be reviewed and cancelled by 4pm to save teams from travelling to a site that is unplayable. On weekend games notice of cancellation should be given no later than two hours before game time.
- 6. The HOST LEAGUE will furnish the official score book and the home team will provide the official scorekeeper. The official scorebook and scorekeeper/pitch counter are not to be in the dugout. They are to be made available to the umpire at all times. The official scorebook will be signed by the scorekeeper at the conclusion of the game. The official scorebook will be made available to the protest committee upon request.
- 7. Each manager shall be responsible for maintaining a pitching affidavit and shall present the records to the official scorekeeper **prior** to the game. If the affidavit is not presented, the game will commence with the team missing the affidavit having each pitcher limited to a MAXIMUM of 20 pitches, until the pitching affidavit is presented. Prior to the start of the 3rd inning, the affidavit must be presented for the game to proceed. (Remember, the pitch counts will be in effect per Little League rules and will be counted.) If affidavit is not produced the game will be suspended and may be restarted at the top of the 3rd inning.

The DA and the League President of the team in violation will be notified within 24 hours of missing pitching affidavit by the game UIC, and will be provided with pitch count information from the game in question to be recorded on the team's pitching affidavit. Leagues are encouraged to review affidavit for adherence to Little League pitch count rules and rest requirements and to attend to managers in violation accordingly.

If a player is playing in multiple divisions, they must be identified on their League's website as a dual player and they must have a separate pitching/catching affidavit that records their number of pitches and innings they

played as a catcher. Dual players must be marked with an * on the lineup card to identify them as a dual player. If a dual player does not have a separate pitching/catching affidavit at the beginning of the game they are ineligible to pitch or catch for the entire game.

All Pitching/Catching Records Shall Be Kept In Ink. Separate Pitching/Catching affidavit for league games and inter-league games is strictly prohibited if a player is not a dual roster player. One pitching/catching affidavit per team shall be used for all games, league and inter-league, for the entire regular season. If multiple sheets are used during the season, all pages must be consecutively marked in ink and kept together. The official scorekeeper and UIC will sign the pitching/catching affidavits.

The penalties for failure to comply with this said rule are as follows:

1st offense: 1 game suspension for the manager 2nd offense: 3 game suspension for the manager

3rd offense: Manager shall be removed from the team and will be ineligible for any all-star or

tournament participation.

- 8. Each league/team will provide at least 2 new baseballs for each game. (An adequate supply of baseballs is required per game.) The official scorekeeper/pitch counter will record pitch counts for both teams on the common affidavit approved by all leagues. A representative from both teams will meet with the UIC and scorekeeper after each inning to verify the pitches thrown. The final pitch counts will be recorded in ink in the official scorebook upon completion of the game.
- 9. The **HOST** league shall prepare the field before each game. **BOTH** teams shall help with clean up after the game, especially the stands and dugouts. **HOST** teams shall break down the fields as needed.
- 10. Games will start at the time specified as scheduled. For Minors games, no new innings to be started after 1:45 minutes from the actual start time. (Rule 4.10c) For Majors games no new innings to be started after 2 hours from the actual start time. Games may be shortened by conditions such as darkness, weather, etc., at the sole discretion of the game UIC once the game has begun.
- 11. The manager/coach shall have with them at all times (practices and games) each players permission to play/medical release form.
- 12. Each league shall supply a **fully equipped first aid kit** for each of their fields.
- 13. 25 minutes before the start of the game the home team will have the opportunity to take the field for infield for up to 10 minutes, to be followed by the visiting team for up to 10 minutes. A plate meeting shall commence before the start of every game. Game UIC to review local ground rules with each manager and other umpire(s) prior to the start of the game. (e.g. play boundary, out of play, etc)
- 14. Home team shall occupy the third base dugout.
- 15. Thrown bat and physical contact policy as defined by District 2 will be enforced.
- 16. FOR AA MINORS DIVISION AND BELOW GAMES ONLY. A runner at 3rd can not advance to home on any unhit pitch or throw back to the pitcher unless forced by base-on-balls or hit batter. Stealing of home is allowed if a play is being made on any runner.
 - a. In the absence of a segregated Minors program, it will be deemed AA Minors for the purpose of this rule.
- 17. **For Minors**, each inning will end after three outs, five runs or one time through the batting order. A five (5) run limit is in effect per half inning for the minor league divisions per the definition of an inning in the rulebook [Rule 2.00]. Following the completion of the play in which the fifth (5th) run is scored in the half inning, the half inning will end. No more than five (5) runs will be recorded per half inning, no exceptions. This division WILL adopt the option provided in Rule 5.07 to suspend the five (5) run limit. It is required that the umpire invokes the 5.07 rule at the top of the inning.

- 18. Continuous batting rule will be used in Majors and Minors inter-league games.
- 19. Manager is responsible to verify bats are legal as approved by Little League.
- 20. Major division does not adopt the option to use the Minor League rule for the uncaught third strike. (Rule 6.09(b))
 - a. Majors can advance on an uncaught third strike.
 - b. Minors cannot advance on an uncaught third strike.
- 21. Managers and coaches shall not warm up the pitchers. (Regulation XIV.F)
- 22. When a team has only eight players in the game this division will not assess an out when the missing ninth batter position comes up to bat. [Rule 4.04]
- 23. This division will adopt the reduced minimum play rule for rosters of 15 or more. [Reg IV(i)]
- 24. This division will adopt the courtesy runner for pitcher/catcher with two outs. The courtesy runner must be the last previous out. [Rule 7.14(b)]

Idaho District 2 Inter-league Rules Baseball Intermediate/Junior/Senior Divisions 2021 Spring Season

1. There will be a joint Board of Directors that will govern the program. It will consist of the President of the league or the Vice-President/Director of the division involved or the Player-Agent for the same division. The District Administrator for the respective division will chair the board.

DISTRICT INTERLEAGUE PROTEST FORMAT: The protest committee will consist of the District Administrator (who is acting in the position of the League President during interleague play) or designated representative, District UIC or designated representative, and one board member from each league involved. Written statements will be accepted by the District Administrator, within 48 hours of the said game, by all involved parties. The committee will review the written statements submitted by the protesting team and the game UIC, as well as interview all parties involved at different time intervals (e.g. both team managers and the game UIC). Only those who are called for an interview will be allowed to attend. This process will take no longer than one week from the time the game was played. Once a ruling has been made, all parties will be notified in writing of the ruling.

- 2. All playing rules will be STRICTLY by the Little League Rule Book and Inter-league rules.
- 3. If after four (4) innings, one team has at least a lead of 15 runs or more, or if after five (5) innings, one team has at least a lead of 10 runs or more, the manager of the team with the least runs must concede. (Rule 4.10(e))
- 4. Each team will furnish a minimum of one certified umpire for all inter-league games. A manager or coach, if certified, may umpire in the field if only one umpire shows up. If more than 2 umpires are present they shall be allowed to umpire (see rule 9.03b). The home team shall provide the plate umpire. In the absence of 2 certified umpires, and the inability or unwillingness of a certified manager or coach to umpire, the game will be suspended and re-scheduled.
- 5. All rescheduling should first go through the managers involved. The managers shall agree to reschedule a game before the end of the season. If the managers cannot come to an acceptable agreement the rescheduling will go through the league director, who will contact the District scheduler. Rainouts and legitimate reasons ONLY will be accepted for rescheduling. Rainouts are determined as outlined per rule 3.10 of the LL rule book. In the event the managers cannot agree upon viewing of the playing conditions before the game, the final determination should be made on site by the UIC. Excluding rainouts, all reasons for rescheduling must be submitted for review by the District scheduler no later than 24 hours before game time. Only TWO OPTIONS for rescheduling will be given per game.

As a courtesy, during times of severe inclement weather it is requested that playing conditions be reviewed and games cancelled by 4pm to save teams from travelling to a site that is unplayable. On weekend games, notice of cancellation should be given no later than two hours before game time.

- 6. The HOST LEAGUE will furnish the official score book and the home team will provide the official scorekeeper. The official scorebook and scorekeeper/pitch counter are not to be in the dugout. They are to be made available to the umpire at all times. The official scorebook will be signed by the scorekeeper at the conclusion of the game. The official scorebook will be made available to the protest committee upon request.
- 7. Each manager shall be responsible for maintaining a pitching affidavit, as approved and on the Idaho District 2 web site and shall present the records to the official scorekeeper **prior** to the game. If the affidavit is not presented, the game will commence with the team missing the affidavit having each pitcher limited to a MAXIMUM of 20 pitches, if the pitcher is league age 14 or under, MAXIMUM of 30 pitches, if the pitcher is between league age 15 and 16, until the pitching affidavit is presented. Prior to the start of the 3rd inning, the affidavit must be presented for the game to proceed. (Remember, the pitch counts will be in effect per Little League rules and will be counted.) If affidavit is not produced the game will be suspended and restarted at the top of the 3rd inning.

The DA and the League President of the team in violation will be notified within 24 hours of missing pitching affidavit by the game UIC, and will be provided with pitch count information from the game in question to be recorded on the teams pitching affidavit. Leagues are encouraged to review affidavit for adherence to Little League pitch count rules and rest requirements and to attend to managers in violation accordingly.

If a player is playing in multiple divisions they must be identified on their League's website as a dual player and they must have a separate pitching/catching affidavit that records their number of pitches and innings they played as a catcher. Dual players must be marked with an * on the lineup card to identify them as a dual player. If a dual player does not have a separate pitching/catching affidavit at the beginning of the game they are ineligible to pitch or catch for the entire game.

All Pitching/Catching Records Shall Be Kept In Ink. Separate Pitching/Catching affidavit for league games and inter-league games is strictly prohibited if a player is not a dual roster player. One pitching/catching affidavit per team shall be used for all games, league and inter-league, for the entire regular season. If multiple sheets are used during the season, all pages must be consecutively marked in ink and kept together. The official scorekeeper and UIC will sign the pitching/catching affidavits.

The penalties for failure to comply with this said rule are as follows:

1st offense: 1 game suspension for the manager 2nd offense: 3 game suspension for the manager

3rd offense: Manager shall be removed from the team and will be ineligible for any all-star or

tournament participation.

The penalties for failing to keep the affidavits in ink are the same as above.

- 8. Each league/team will provide at least 2 new baseballs for each game. (An adequate supply of baseballs is required per game.) The official scorekeeper/pitch counter will record pitch counts for both teams on the common affidavit approved by all leagues. A representative from both teams will meet with the UIC and scorekeeper after each inning to verify the pitches thrown. The final pitch counts will be recorded in ink in the official scorebook upon completion of the game.
- 9. The **HOST** league shall prepare the field before each game. **BOTH** teams shall help with clean up after the game, especially the stands and dugouts. **HOST** team shall break down the fields as needed.
- 10. Weekday games shall start at 6:00pm or 6:30pm depending upon site. Saturday games are as scheduled. There are no time limits on games, unless playing a doubleheader, in which case there will be a 2.5 hour time limit on the first game.
 - a. Game umpires should strictly adhere to the safety standard of suspending games for darkness
- 11. The manager/coach shall have with them at all times (practices and games) each player's permission to play/medical release form.
- 12. Each league shall supply a **fully equipped first aid kit** for each of their fields.
- 13. 30 minutes before the start of the game the home team will have the opportunity to take the field for infield for up to 12 minutes, to be followed by the visiting team for up to 12 minutes. A plate meeting shall commence before the start of every game. Game UIC to review local ground rules with each manager and other umpire(s) prior to the start of the game. (i.e. play boundary, out of play, etc)
- 14. Home team shall occupy the third base dugout.
- 15. Thrown bat and physical contact policy as defined by District 2 policy will be enforced.
- 16. Every team with its regular season roster will be invited to participate in the end of season tournament.

- 17. Both the winning and losing managers will report the game score to the District within 24 hours of the completion of the game. Report scores via e-mail to scores@idaho2littlleague.org
- 18. Continuous batting rule will be used for inter-league games at all divisions.
- 19. NOTE: End of Season Tournament will use regular season pitching rules. Pitch counts will not reset so all rest requirements must be met. Tournaments are single eliminations and will begin immediately following the regular season schedule as soon as scheduling can be completed.
- 20. Manager is responsible to verify bats are legal as approved by Little League.
- 21. Managers and coaches shall not warm up the pitchers. (Regulation XIV.F)
- 22. When a team has only eight players in the game this division will not assess an out when the missing ninth batter position comes up to bat. [Rule 4.04]
- 23. This division will adopt the reduced minimum play rule for rosters of 15 or more. [Reg IV(i)]
- 24. This division will adopt the courtesy runner for pitcher/catcher with two outs. The courtesy runner must be the last previous out. [Rule 7.14(b)]
